Question 1: Does SCEL currently subscribe to any compensation surveys that the awarded consultant would incorporate into the analysis? If so, which surveys?

SCEL Response: SCEL does not "subscribe" to any particular organization's compensation survey, however, SCEL has participated in providing compensation information to requesting entities, such as the North American Association of State & Provincial Lotteries (NASPL), Ogletree Deakins (external counsel benchmarking surveys), the Florida Lottery (job/salary comparisons), etc. SCEL anticipates that the data collected through these surveys will be shared with SCEL during this process, but the inclusion of this data into the final analysis would not be mandatory.

Question 2: How many employee interviews are expected to take place?

SCEL Response: At this time, SCEL's HR Department anticipates that approximately 30 employee interviews will need to be conducted; however the number of interviews are subject to change based on the Contractor's needs to successfully perform the work.

Question 3: Would SCEL accept a job analysis questionnaire process in lieu of employee interviews?

SCEL Response: The awarded Contractor will be expected to conduct employee interviews in addition to the completion of a Job Content Questionnaire (JCQ) or other similar form (i.e. job analysis questionnaire, etc.) in order to properly evaluate the nuances of each particular position. The JCQ could only be substituted in lieu of an employee interview if the awarded Contractor has worked with the SC Education Lottery in the past, or another lottery, who has identical job titles/descriptions for particular roles. Not every employee will need to

be interviewed, as SCEL has only 48 unique job titles, although our current staff count is 130. To be considered for award, Offerors should submit a sample Job Content Questionnaire or other similar form (i.e. job analysis questionnaire, etc.) as described in Section IV.: Information for Offerors to Submit; (II) Technical Proposal – Parts A. & B. (RFP page 16).
