Page 2 dealing the Iran Divestment Act, states the certification is needed for procurements over \$10,000. The Open Trade information presented on page 3 states the certification does not apply to procurements under \$10,000. The table on page 14 provides pricing information from the last procurement of curbside signs with a different stand in 2014.

Vendors should monitor the website to check for amendments and will need to acknowledge they had the opportunity to read any amendments posted when sending their quote.
