## **Question 1**

- Q: Can companies from Outside USA can apply for this? (like, from India or Canada)
- A: Yes, with the exception of companies on the Iran Divestment Act List, companies outside the US may bid on this solicitation. See Page 11, Clause [02-2A077-2]; See Page 28 Clause [07-7A072-1].

#### **Question 2**

Q: Are vendors required to come to Columbia, South Carolina, for meetings?

A: No, vendors do not need to come to Columbia, S.C. This procurement has no conferences or meetings.

## **Question 3**

- Q: Can we perform the tasks (related to RFP) outside USA? (like, from India or Canada)
- A: The solicitation is an Invitation for Bids (IFB), not an RFP (Request for Proposals). Yes, these promotional items may be manufactured outside the USA.

#### **Question 4**

- Q: Can we submit the proposals via email?
- A: No, only sealed bids delivered by mail or by hand will be accepted for Invitation to Bids (IFB). As stated several times in the solicitation: Emailed bids NOT accepted.

- Q: We do not quote t-shirts as a rule, can we quote all other items. If we quote all items, will any of the items be awarded by item?
- A: No to both questions. As stated multiple times in the solicitation, the bid is for 18 items in one lot. Bids received that are not for all items will be found non-responsive and ineligible for award.

#### **Question 6**

- Q: I have a couple of questions for the FY19 Promo 1 IFB bid. 1. What is the max pallet size?
- A: The maximum pallet size is listed under § III. SCOPE OF WORK/SPECIFICATIONS. See Page 20.

## Question 7

- Q: 2. For the tote bags, do they need to be individually polybagged inside the boxes? The individually polybagged does add cost
- A: No, the tote bags do NOT have to be individually poly-bagged. Allowing tote bags not to be poly-bagged is a change from the tote bag specifications in the IFB.

## **Question 8**

- Q: 3. For the gloves, do all the fingers have to have charcoal tips? We can get a much better deal on gloves that have three tips (thumb, index, and middle).
- A: No, all fingers do not have to have charcoal tips. Gloves with three tips (thumb, index, and middle) will be accepted as long as the three tipped fingers feature conductive fibers to provide universal touchscreen compatibility. Gloves <u>must be</u> made with acrylic fiber and have conductive fiber in the thumb, index, and middle fingertips to interact with devices. Allowing three tipped gloves is a change from the glove specifications in the IFB.

## **Q: 4. Is the attached tumbler a suitable replacement?**

16 oz Acrylic Tumbler



A: No. A: No. This alternative tumbler is NOT acceptable.

## **Question 10**

## **Q: 5. Is early delivery allowed?**

A: Yes, though delivery for this IFB must be made <u>after July 1, 2018</u>. The SCEL warehouse does receive deliveries every week and has ONE loading dock. It is necessary to coordinate when deliveries are being <u>made to ensure the loading dock is free</u>. If your delivery will be other than in the week and time specified in the solicitation (the week of September 17, no later than 11 a.m. local time on Friday, September 21, 2018), please let the Procurement Official know so that the delivery can be scheduled for a time that staff is present and the loading dock is available. Additionally, the warehouse is closed from noon to 1 p.m. for lunch. Please plan your deliveries to arrive between 8 and 11 in the morning or between 1 and 3 in the afternoon with the exception of Friday, when deliveries should be finished by noon. At other times of the day the loading dock may be in use.

#### Question 11

- Q: If a vendor is asked to provide samples, do the samples have to be labeled with the vendor's information? To save time should a vendor have their distributor mail the samples directly to SCEL?
- A: The samples received from the requested vendors must be labeled with the name of the solicitation and the vendor on the package and contain the vendor's information on each sample. If a vendor's distributor does not

clearly label each sample, then the vendor should have the samples sent to the vendor and be labeled before sending to SCEL. If a sample cannot clearly be tied to a vendor, the sample will be found non-responsive. Likewise, if a package cannot be clearly associated with a specific procurement AND vendor, the package will be found non-responsive. As SCEL may well have more than one solicitation being held at the same time, each response to a solicitation must be clearly marked.

# Question 12

Q: Would an alternative tumbler as shown in the attachments be acceptable? It meets the material specs and size but is a different style/lid type.



**A:** No. This alternative tumbler is NOT acceptable.
