CORRECTION NUMBER 2:

On Page 24, under Section VIII. BIDDING SCHEDULE / PRICE-BUSINESS PROPOSAL, under Paragraph "Color," the imprint size is given as 8 5/8" x 3 3/4". The correct imprint size is 9 inches (h) X 4 inches (w) with a 1/8 inch bleed.

Q: Question, what was the last time you ordered these, the quantity and the price you paid?

A: Thank you for your question. Play Slip Covers were last put out to bid on August 17, 2018. The solicitation was for 300,000 Play Slip Covers; the winning bid had a unit price of \$0.089 and was for \$26,700, including shipping. Sale/use tax not included in winning bid price.
