- Q: Can I email you the quote or do I need to print out the bid sheet and fill it in and scan to you?
- A: Thank you for asking a great question. Solicitations advertised through the South Carolina Business Opportunities Website [SCBO] are more formal and need a formal response to ensure that Vendors who wish to request Preferences have the format to make their requests. Vendors not requesting any Preferences should check "No" in the "Response" column for each of the three types of Preferences.

- 2) Page 17, with the Minority Participation information completed;
- The bidding schedule found on Pages 27-28 Pages 6 and 7 of this amendment. Please check over the Bidding Schedule to ensure all Preference Questions have been answered for each line item; and Note: Only Page 7 needs to be returned.
- 4) Acknowledgement of any amendments issued. Questions are to be sent in writing to POS@SCLot.com and received by 11 a.m. local time on Tuesday, May 3, 2022. An Amendment answering any questions received is normally issued the next day. A: Yes.

Q: If yes, when was it ordered last?

A: A solicitation for 5,000 Play Station Toppers with different art was posted on Wednesday, January 2, 2019. An award was issued on Wednesday, January 23, 2019.

Q: Quantity?

A: The earlier January 2019 solicitation was for 5,000 Play Station Toppers.

Q: Price delivered please.

A: Total Evaluated Amount: \$18,700.00 (Production and Delivery. No Taxes.)

Question 6

- Q: If we quote as 6 colors (6/6), it will need to go thru the press twice. To save SC Lottery money, we can make everything out of 4CP or 4CP+1 PMS (5/5), if that is acceptable.
- A: Thank you for bringing possible cost savings to SCEL's attention. We would like to get pricing for the three options: 4CP, 4CP+1 PMS (5/5), and 6/6. Please use the new Bidding Schedule / Price-Business Proposal found on Pages 6 and 7 of this amendment. Please return Page 7 with your quote. In addition, Offerors should return the three additional pages as provided in Question 1.

Please see Question 7 below for changes in the quantity ordered and the packaging requested.

Question 7

- Q: If we pack as spec'd, you're looking at a 26x22x16 box weighing @ 60lbs. Is that acceptable?
- A: Thank you for bringing the possible 60 pound box weight to SCEL's attention. To make the boxes lighter, the bundling amount and way packaged as well as the quantity ordered are changing. The quantity ordered is increasing by 50 toppers, going from 6,250 to 6,300 toppers.

- Color: Printed with UV ink; overall design is 4/4 <u>either a 4/4, 4CP+1 PMS (5/5), or a 6/6</u> color process and the SCEL logo is the usual PMS colors; double-sided; with different art on the back stating where to put the adhesive. Two (2) PMS colors in SCEL logo and the blue in the art itself: PMS 286 (blue) and PMS 361 (green). Bleed: Yes, all sides. Please see SCEL's Brand Color Sheet attached.
