#### REMINDERS

BY STATE LAW, ODDS INFORMATION MUST BE DISPLAYED IN ALL RETAIL OUTLETS ADJACENT TO SCEL POINT OF SALE. This information is included in the piece called "Odds of Our Games."

Display the Top Prizes Remaining Report: Every morning when you sign in the terminal will generate a "Top Prizes Remaining" report. Post this updated report in the clear sleeve or change mat on your counter. The clear sleeve must be on your dispenser or near the point of purchase.

The Lottery provides updated, weekly prizes remaining and end-of-game information. It is also sent out in all ticket orders. Make sure you review and display the most current information in your play station.

Scratch-off fact sheets with odds and prize information are attached to a ring on the play station. Encourage players to read the information, but discourage them from removing this resource.

The Scratch-off Ticket Information Sign and About Our Odds Sign must be posted at or near the point of purchase.

### HEAR FROM THE BIGGEST TICKET SELLER IN THE UPSTATE ON HOW TO SUCCEED AND HAVE FUN

As we start 2024, we're going to take a look back at a retailer that had a good year. Actually, it was a great year at the **Garden Spot #4**.

The neighborhood store in **Taylors** sold more lottery tickets than any other place in the Upstate. It's surprising, considering the store isn't located on a busy road and doesn't have gas pumps either. And that's exactly why we think anyone can learn from their success and be inspired by their story.

When the doors are open at the Garden Spot #4, it's a safe bet someone is inside playing their lucky numbers or scratching a lottery ticket or two. Store manager Mike Baldauff says his family has run the store since the 1960s. It all started with his grandfather, passed to his uncle and then his mom Betty took over the business.

"I grew up in the store, was a bag boy when I was little kid and a cashier in high school," said Mike. After practicing law for two decades, Mike decided to move from Georgia back home to South Carolina to help his mom operate the store after its longtime manager left. Today he works alongside his mom and wife Kathleen.

The store was selling a ton of lottery tickets before Mike's return, but last year alone they did \$370,000 more in ticket sales. They also cracked the Lottery's list of Top 5 retailers.

"It's amazing how much business we do, it blows my mind," Mike said. "Some customers come in every day and buy a couple of tickets and others hang out for hours with us."

But why this place? What makes it special? If you've ever watched the 80s television show *Cheers*, Mike says the "where everybody knows your name" feel is what separates the Garden Spot #4 store from the rest. "We know 99 percent of our customers," said Mike. "My wife has their names and numbers in her cell phone. If someone is having surgery, we are going to check on them. If we haven't seen someone in a few days, we are going to make sure they are all right. We have a great relationship with our customers."

Their other secret weapon is laughter.

Nothing gets more laughs than the messages Kathleen thinks up to go on their outdoor sign. One of her recent creations is pictured above. She wrote this one when the Powerball® jackpot was ridiculously high. "Our customers love them," Mike said. "It brings people in and is something to talk about. And we like to goof off with them."

> Mike's got a sense of humor too. He told us his first year back at the store they sold winning tickets worth \$100,000, \$375,000 and \$200,000, so he figured winning the lottery must not be that hard.
